### **Eldorado High School (EHS) GEAR UP Abstract**

Eldorado High School serves approximately 3100 students with the Eldorado Preparatory Academy (ninth grade only) located at the west campus on Maryland Parkway. Demographic information includes: 50% male, 50% female, 14% African American, 6% Asian/Pacific Islander, 56% Hispanic, 1% Native American, and 24% Caucasian. Additionally, 17% of the population is identified as LEP, 12% IEP, and 36% as Free or Reduced Lunch program.

To support the GEAR UP goals of student achievement, Eldorado Preparatory Academy offers both in-class and after school tutoring in core subjects, proficiency exam workshops and tutoring, incentives/awards for students who maintain perfect attendance and superior grades, summer school scholarships, a credit retrieval program, and individual academic advising to identify and reach academic goals.

College access for all students is encouraged through tours of University of Nevada Las Vegas, Nevada State College, and College of Southern Nevada. Career exploration exposes students to skills and the pre-requisite education needed to succeed in postsecondary education. The College Bound Academy is a series of monthly workshops designed to assist students with academic choices that lead to success on the college path. Additional workshops focus on social skills as well as college financial aid and scholarship information for both parents and students.
