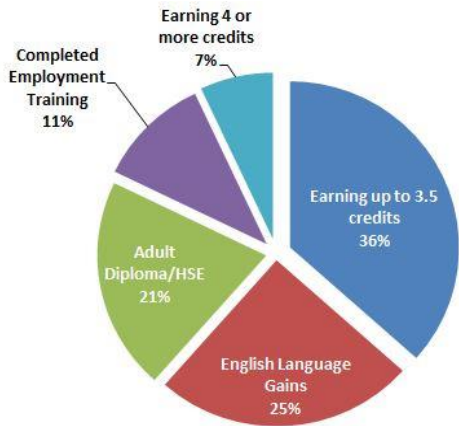

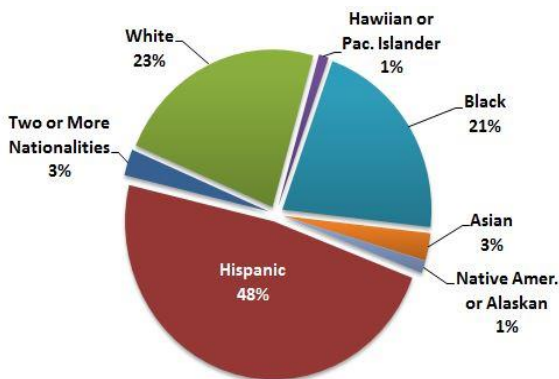

### Adult Learner Outcomes



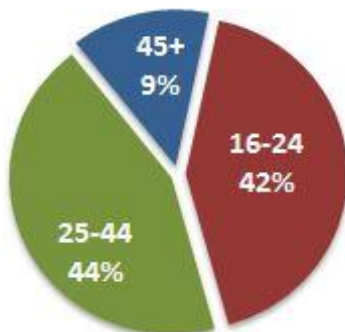

Adult High Schools provide opportunities for Nevada adults to:

Return to school and earn their High School Equivalency Certificate or Adult High School Diploma

- ❖ Get a job
- ❖ Keep their job
- ❖ Get off welfare
- ❖ Transfer to college or other career and technical training programs
- ❖ Learn English language skills, understand US culture, and participate in society
- ❖ Help their children with homework and be successful in school

Adult High Schools Provide Diplomas and Certificates

- ❖ 2,588 adult high school diplomas and HSE were awarded in 2016-2017
- ❖ 9,446 high school credits were awarded to learners who were previously considered “non-graduates” or “drop-outs”.
- ❖ 1,356 students completed employability training
