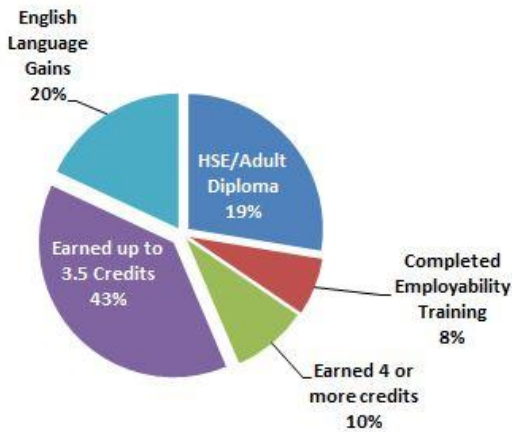

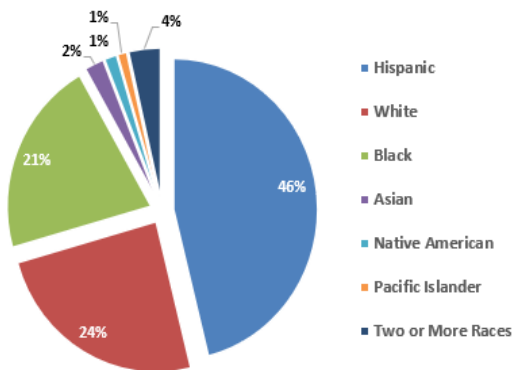
Adult high school programs are operated by 14 local school districts in Nevada

Adult Learner Outcomes



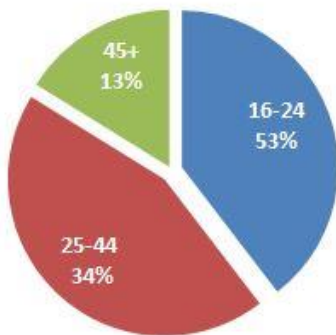

Adult High Schools Provide Diplomas and Certificates

- ❖ 3,074 adult high school diplomas and HSE were awarded in 2018-2019
- ❖ 761 students completed employability training
- ❖ 15,190 students made gains toward their educational goals

Enrollment in AHSD Programs Decline

In FY19, the AHSD program served 15,190 students. This is a decrease of 10,985 students compared to a near record high of 26,175 students served in FY18. This decrease can be attributed to low unemployment rates and more accurate reporting.
