Opened this Fall



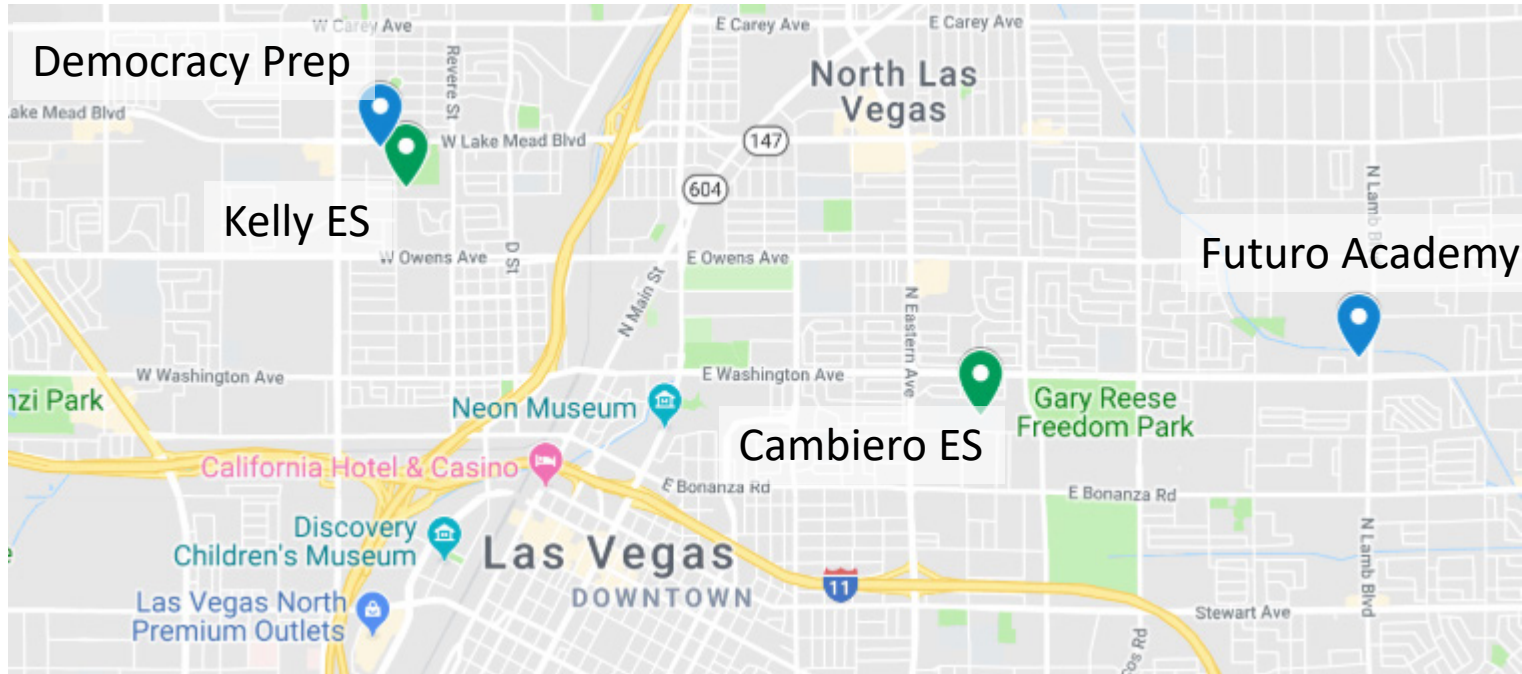
Over 1,500 new seats added near underperforming and overcrowded Schools in Clark County. Ultimately, these four schools will provide over 2,600 seats once all schools reach full scale.

Cambiero Elementary School was paired with Futuro Academy in 2016 and increased its index score by 39.5 points from 2017 to 2018. Cambiero Elementary School is now a 3-Star school.

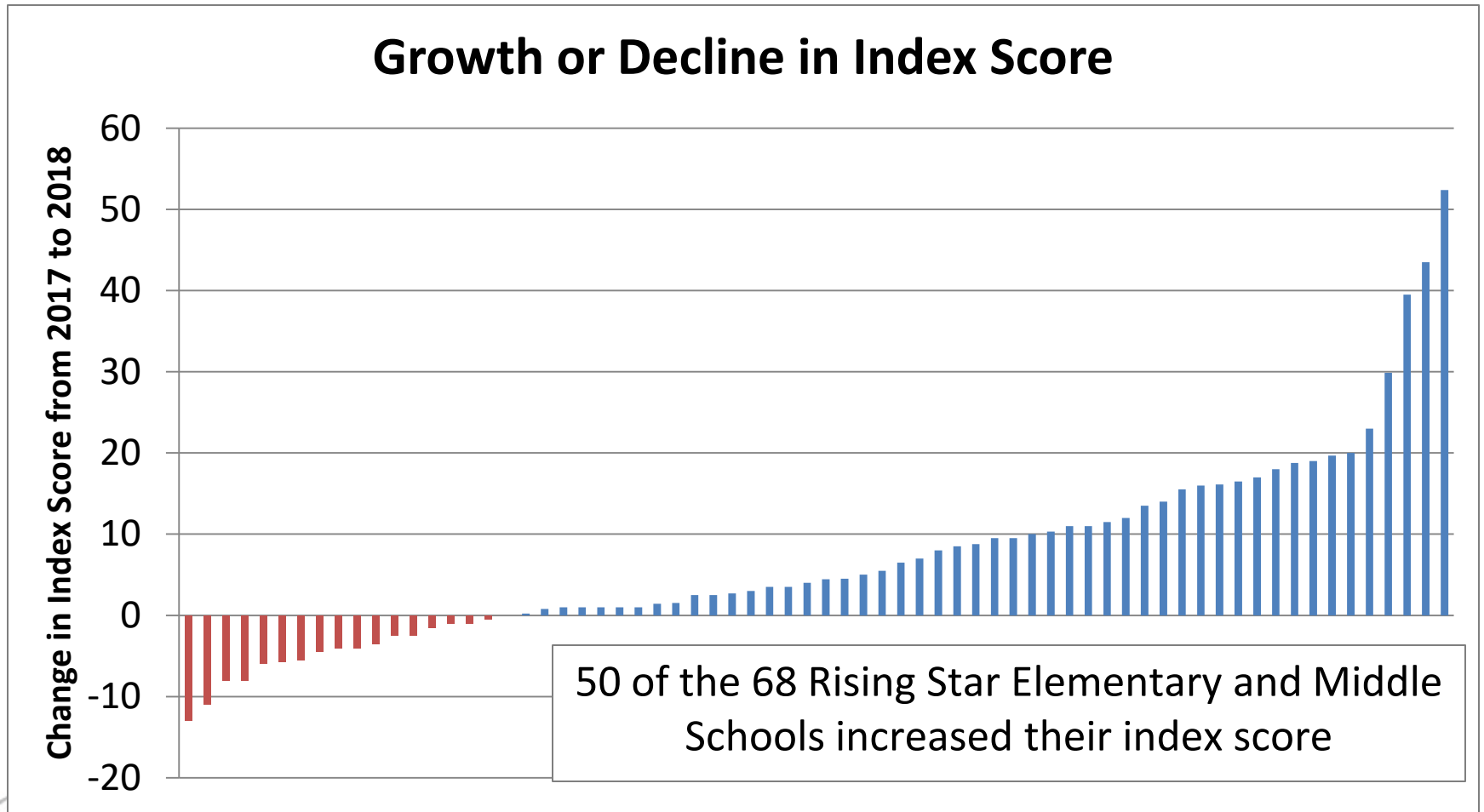
Matt Kelly Elementary School increased 17 index points from 2017 to 2018 and now is a 2-star school. Kelly Elementary School is located $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile from Democracy Prep.

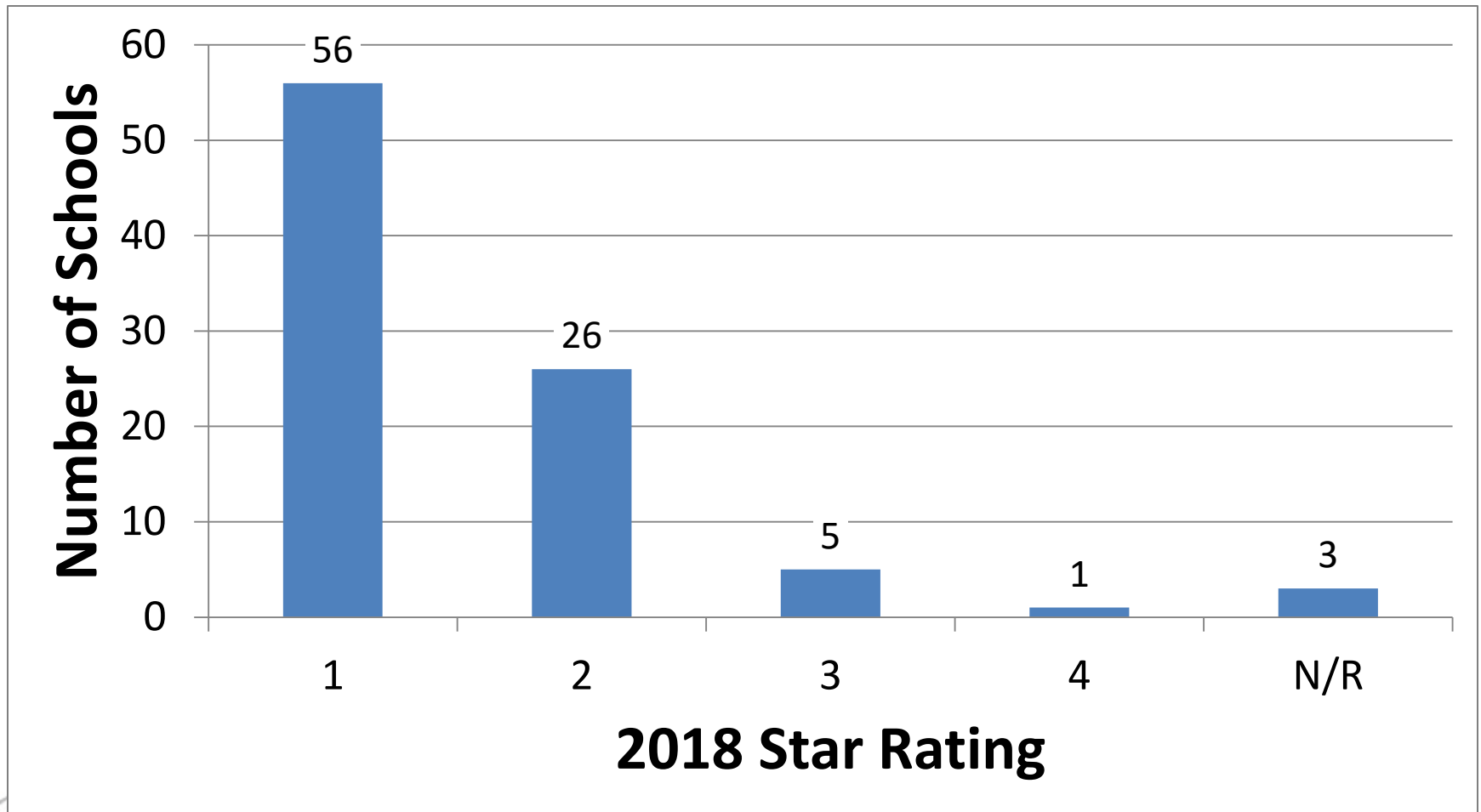

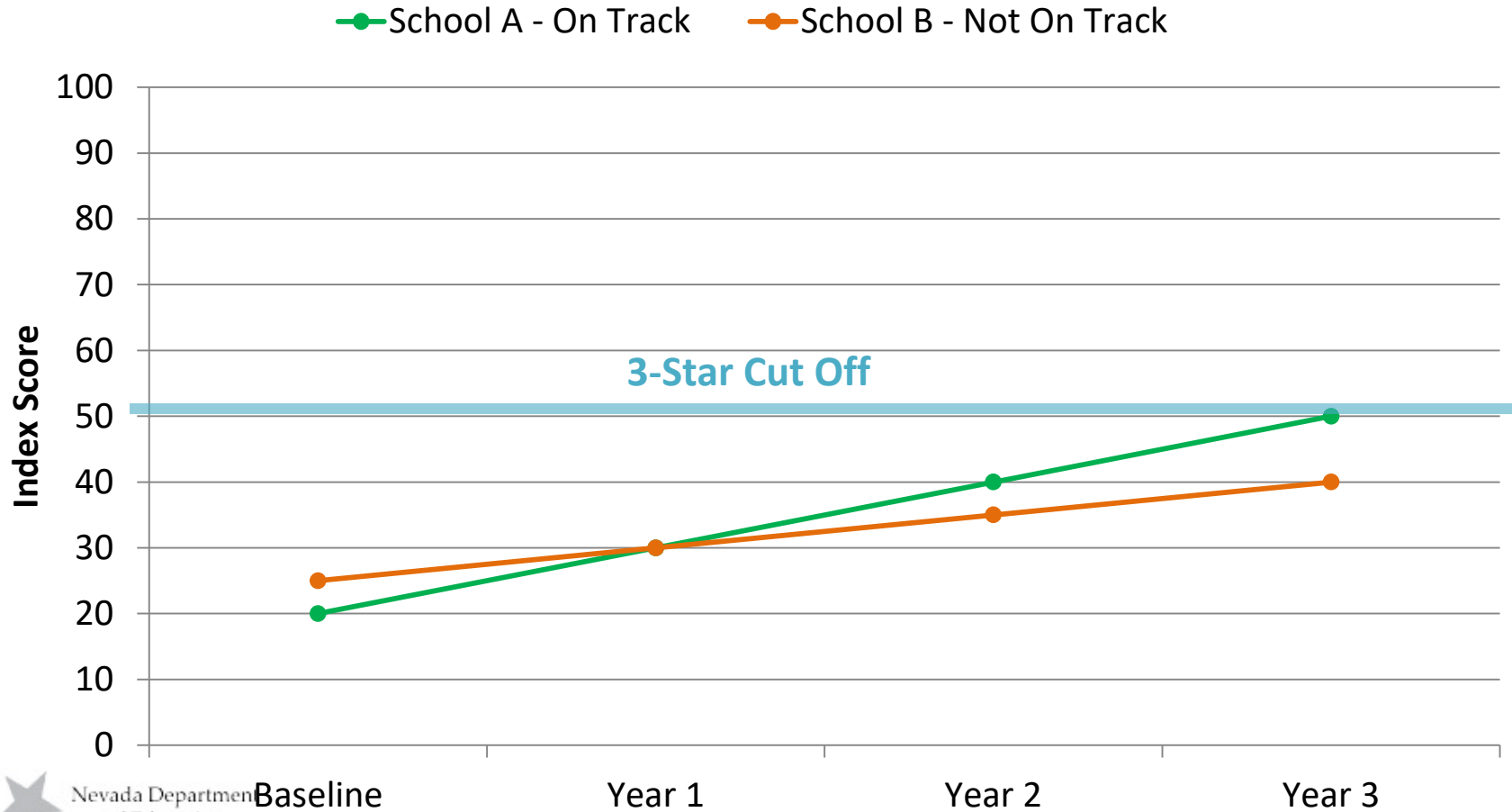

2018 Star Ratings for 2017 Rising Stars Schools

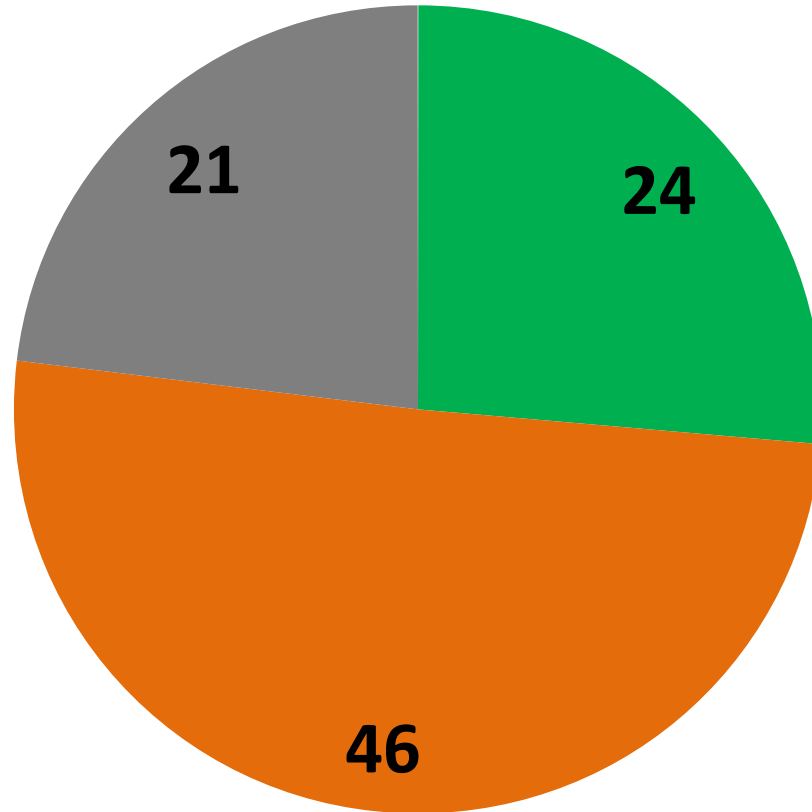


Achieving 3-Stars in 3 years

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Update on the Partnership Network

- Clark County applied for and received competitive grant funding to fund the Partnership Network
- 28 CCSD Schools Participating
- NDE continues to support CCSD with the initiative

Achievement School District 2018 School Selection Process

- 79 schools meet the eligibility criteria based on (bottom 5%, 1-star, or graduation rate below 67%)
 - Schools on the Alternate Performance Framework are not eligible
 - Schools with a current performance compact with the state are not eligible (10 schools across 4 districts are currently on performance compacts)
- 40 of the schools were identified as Rising Stars Schools in 2017

Nevada Department of Education publishes list of Rising Star Schools and schools eligible for the Nevada ASD

By Nov. 30

Nevada ASD recommends at least 20% of eligible schools

Nevada ASD selects up to six schools and pairs them with operators or transformation teams

Parent Petition Window

Petitions Due Nov. 15

Petition Eligibility

All ASD-Eligible Schools

Schools that are automatically eligible for the Nevada ASD

- Bottom 5% of elementary, middle and high schools
- High School with a graduation rate below 67%
- Schools recommended by board of trustees

Schools that may petition for an ASD or non-ASD turnaround strategy*

- 1-Star Schools
- *As long as the school does not meet any of the other criteria*

**If the parents do not petition, the school is by default eligible for the Nevada ASD*

Of the 79 schools eligible for the Nevada ASD, 58 meet the criteria for parent petition.

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PARENT PETITION

What is a petition?

A petition is a formal document signed by many people requesting a specific outcome.

What is a Parent Petition under Nevada State Law?

The Parent Petition is a way for parents and guardians with children at certain **Rising Stars Schools** that are not meeting Nevada State Standards to advocate for a change to improve their child's school. Each petition must have a specific "School Plan." Parents and guardians who are in favor of the School Plan can sign an official signature page to show their support for the plan.

District Requirements related to Parent Petition (Regulation R108-15)

- Post Rising Stars List and information about parent petition to district website
- For ASD-eligible schools, provide names of parents/guardians and contact information to the ASD

Process for Petitions Submitted to Nevada ASD

- ***Due to Nevada ASD by November 15***
 - Using petitioning form approved by State Board in June
- Within 15 days the Nevada ASD
 - Will determine whether the petition is valid
 - Send a written summary of the determination to the lead petitioner(s)
 - Send a written summary of the determination to the State Board
- The results of any valid petitions will be reflected in the Nevada ASD Recommendations to the State Board by November 30
- For any valid petitions, the State Board will adopt a resolution, approving the petition, at the December Board Meeting

Urban Prep Las Vegas (Deferred from last year)	College Prep - Specializes in serving young men	9-12 (Starting with Grade 9)
Explore Academy	College Prep - Unique academic structure that educates students through choice-based, individualized model	6-12 (Starting with grades 6, 7 and 9)
