Selection Process

- Committee of six (6) previous NV Teacher of the Year recipients individually reviewed applications.
 - Rubric aligned with Council of Chief State School Officers (CCSSO) National Expectations
- Phone Screenings and Panel Interviews conducted.
- Five candidates receiving the highest scores were submitted to Superintendent Ebert.
- Superintendent Ebert selected 2020 NV Teacher of the Year.
