The State Board of Education will receive an overview of the Milken Educator Award (MEA) program and present the MEA Obelisk to Ali Jun – Nevada’s 2021 recipient.

Overview

- Initiative of the Milken Family Foundation
- Recipients receive \$25,000 of unrestricted funds
- Targets early-to-mid-career educators that are unsung heroes providing exemplary service
- Process is confidential and the recipients receive the award at a surprise school-wide event

Goals of the Program

- To honor and reward outstanding K-12 educators for the quality of their teaching, their professional leadership, their engagement with families and the community, and their potential for even greater contributions to the healthy development of children.
- To focus public attention on the importance of excellent educators.
- To encourage able, caring, and creative people to choose the challenge, service, and adventure of teaching as a career.
- To create national and state networks of Milken Educators that:
 - foster the active professional development and career enhancement of Milken Educators and other professionals,
 - encourage Milken Educators to help shape the educational policies that influence their classrooms and schools,
 - connect Milken Educators with the educational improvement efforts of state and federal education agencies, universities, educators, corporate partners and others.
- To engage corporate and foundation partners in assisting Milken Educators and in supporting policies that advance education.

Criteria for Selection

- Sourced via a confidential process
- Reviewed by a blue-ribbon panel facilitated by the Department
- Final approval is done by the Milken Family Foundation
- Recommended educators must include all of the following:
 - Exceptional educational talent as evidenced by effective and innovative instructional practices and student learning results in the classroom and school.
 - Exemplary educational accomplishments and leadership beyond the classroom that provide models of excellence for the profession;
 - Be individuals whose contributions to education are largely unheralded yet worthy of the spotlight.
 - Be early- to mid-career educators who offer strong long-range potential for professional and policy leadership.
 - Engaging and inspiring presence that motivates and impacts students, colleagues, and the community.
