1. Complete the general requirements for all educator licenses: [General License Requirements](#)
2. Bachelor's or more advanced degree from an accredited college/university; and
3. Forty-one (41) credits of coursework in elementary professional education consisting of the following areas:
 - A. Eight (8) credits in supervised student teaching in elementary grades
 - B. Eighteen (18) semester credits in methods of teaching elementary subjects consisting of the following, with instruction in assessment and evaluation embedded in all required courses:
 1. Nine (9) semester credits in the teaching of literacy or language arts
 2. Three (3) semester credits in the teaching of mathematics
 3. Three (3) semester credits in the teaching of science
 4. Three (3) semester credits in the teaching of social studies
 - C. Fifteen (15) semester credits in elementary curriculum and program implementation which must include three (3) semester credits of coursework in each of the following subjects:
 1. Classroom and behavior management, including, without limitation, social, emotional, and academic development
 2. Multicultural education and culturally relevant pedagogy
 3. Multi-tiered systems of support
 4. Strategies for working with children with disabilities
 5. Child development and learning
4. Eighteen (18) credits as follows: (*Content area, not methods*)
 1. Six (6) credits in mathematics
 2. Six (6) credits in science
 3. Six (6) credits in social studies
