1. Complete the general requirements for all educator licenses: [General License Requirements](#)
2. Bachelor's or more advanced degree from an accredited college/university; and
3. Complete twelve (12) semester credits in professional education to include at least six (6) semester credits in the methods of teaching basic subjects: literacy or language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies; and
  - A. Complete twenty-four (24) semester credits in American Sign Language from an accredited college/university; or
  - B. Hold one of the following:
    1. An American Sign Language Teachers Association Certificate issued by the American Sign Language Teachers Association
    2. An Interpreting Certificate issued by the National Association of the Deaf (Must be Level 4 Certificate or Above)
    3. A certificate of Interpretation or Certificate of Transliteration issued by the Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf; or
    4. A Certificate as a Certified Deaf Interpreter issued by the Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf
