

GUIDANCE MEMORANDUM #19-05

SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2020 SB 178 Allocation

This memo provides information as to how the Account for the New Nevada Education Funding Plan (SB 178), to which \$69,937,200 is appropriated for school year 2019-20, will be allocated.^{1 2}

The 2019-20 allocations are informed by the Nevada School Performance Framework (NSPF) star ratings as well as student achievement data. The total number of schools that will be funded by SB 178 in the 2019-20 school year will be 458 schools. The total number of students that will be funded by SB 178 in the 2019-20 school year is 58,281. For a breakdown of funding across districts and schools, see Appendix A.

SB 178 is implemented in [NRS 387.129](#), [387.131](#), [387.133](#), [387.137](#), and [387.139](#). Additionally, [SB 549](#), which enhanced SB 178, was passed by the Legislature and approved by the Governor in June 2019.

Per [NRS 387.131](#):

1. By July 1 of each year, the Nevada Department of Education (NDE) must determine the number of pupils in each public school who: (1) are English learners or eligible for a free or reduced lunch; (2) score in the bottom 25th percentile on an assessment of proficiency; (3) are not enrolled in a Zoom or Victory school; and (4) do not have an individualized education plan (IEP).
2. The NDE shall provide a per pupil amount of \$1,200 for each pupil identified to each school starting with the lowest rated school until funding is exhausted.
3. By July 15 of each year, the NDE shall transfer SB 178 funds to districts and charter sponsors.

¹ The grand total amount exceeds the GF appropriation included in SB 555 (2019 Session) by \$200; this will be funded through interest income earned on the account.

² Additional interest income is anticipated in FY2020; this funds will be distributed separately.

Per [NRS 387.137](#) and [SB 549 \(2019\)](#), the NDE shall use the following assessment data to determine student eligibility for the 2019-20 school year allocation. These data reflect student achievement from the 2017-18 school year.

1. English Language Proficiency Assessment results for English Learners in any grade (WIDA assessment).
2. MAP assessment results for kindergarten and grades 1 and 2.
3. Summative assessment results for grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 (Smarter Balanced Assessment).
4. The assessment implemented by the NDE for grades 9 and 10 (High School Science Assessment).
5. The college and career readiness assessment for grades 11 (ACT).

Per [NRS 387.129](#), funding allocations must be directed by districts and charter schools to a special revenue fund and cannot be commingled with other funds. Additionally, per [NRS 387.131](#), districts and charter schools shall distribute the money to each identified public school on a per pupil basis for each pupil identified. As such, the funding allocations listed in Appendix A are intended to reach the schools at the dollar amount indicated to service the eligible students.

[NRS 387.133](#) states that a public school that receives SB 178 funds must use the funds only on programs or services which are evidence-based, as outlined in [20 U.S.C. §7801\(21\)](#). The permissible uses of SB 178 funds is based on what we know works from the Victory and Zoom programs plus other evidence based interventions, programs, and services. Programs piloted through the Victory and Zoom programs are also permissible and the NDE stands ready to assist districts in identifying high quality, evidence based programs and services.

A minimum of ninety percent of the funds must be spent on the following:

Evidence-based, as defined in 20 U.S.C. § 7801(21)*

*This refers to ESSA evidence levels 1-4: Strong, Moderate, Promising, or Demonstrates a Rationale

- Extended learning opportunities (including, but not limited to):
 - Summer academy
 - Intersession academy
 - Before or after school program
 - Extended school day
 - Learning opportunity at another time when school is not in session
- Academic interventions (including, but not limited to):
 - Reading or literacy center
 - Administration of a common, valid, and reliable formative and summative assessment
- Early childhood education, including a prekindergarten program
- Any other strategy designed by the public school and approved by the Department
- Parent and family engagement programs or services
- School climate and culture programs
- Social, psychological, or health care services to pupils and their families (including, but not limited to):
 - Counseling
 - Wrap-around services

Evidence-based, as defined in 20 U.S.C. § 7801(21)(A)(i)**

**This refers to ESSA evidence levels 1-3: Strong, Moderate, or Promising

- Academic interventions:
 - Implementation of curriculum or software, which may include, without limitation, a course of instruction in college and career readiness;
 - Hiring of personnel to implement an academic intervention

No more than 10% of SB 178 funds can be spent on the following:

Evidence-based, as defined in 20 U.S.C. § 7801(21)*

*This refers to ESSA evidence levels 1-4: Strong, Moderate, Promising, or Demonstrates a Rationale

- Reimbursement for coursework required to obtain endorsement relating to English language acquisition and development for teachers and other licensed educational personnel serving EL students
- Retention incentives for teachers or other licensed educational personnel serving EL students and have obtained endorsement

Evidence-based, as defined in 20 U.S.C. § 7801(21)(A)(i)**

**This refers to ESSA evidence levels 1-3: Strong, Moderate, or Promising

- Professional development

Per [NRS 387.133](#), before using the funds the public school must consult with staff, parents, legal guardians, and school organization team (if one exists) on which permissible uses of funds the school will dedicate the funding towards. Together the public school, staff, parents, legal guardians, and school organization team (if one exists) are to create a plan for the use of the funds and the goals to be achieved as a result of the funding.

Per [NRS 387.139](#), the NDE is required to prescribe annual measurable objectives and performance targets aligned to the statewide system of accountability for schools who receive funding to evaluate and track the performance of SB 178 pupils to ensure a high return on investment for eligible students. The NDE chose to align these objectives and targets to the long term goals and measures of interim progress contained within Nevada's ESSA plan. This aligns SB 178 funding with the annual measurable objectives and performance targets for Zoom and Victory Schools.
