## **NEVADA LEADERSHIP LEARNING NETWORKS (NLLN)**

The Nevada Department of Education is partnering with WestEd to launch new learning networks for central office administrators and school leadership teams in our state.

As a part of our overall system of support for schools, the Nevada Leadership Learning Networks (NLLN) provide opportunities for educational leaders to learn through:

### **Launched Fall 2022: School Leadership Team Networks (SLTN)**

- The School Leadership Team Networks (SLTN) are school leadership teams who come together with national experts to expand effectiveness through collaboration with a focus on strengthening instructional leadership.
- Six, 2.5 hour sessions

### **Launching January 2023: Micro-Networks**

- The Micro Networks offer school and district leaders professional learning focused on advancing effective leadership and supervisory practices.
- Three, 2 hour sessions

### **Launching Summer 2023: The Supervisors of Principals' Academy (SOPA)**

- SOPA participants are current principal supervisors dedicated to advancing coaching and evaluation practices. Participants learn and practice using tools and research to refine their skillset.
- Monthly, 2 hour sessions
